

SHAMOKIN TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 1968 - 1

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A PER CAPITA TAX FOR GENERAL PURPOSES ON EACH RESIDENT OR INHABITANT OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SHAMOKIN TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE AND OVER.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SHAMOKIN TOWNSHIP, NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, IN REGULAR MEETING ASSEMBLED, AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED PURSUANT TO THE DICTATES OF AN ACT OF GENERAL ASSEMBLY APPROVED THE 31ST DAY OF DECEMBER, 1965, NO. 511, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1966, KNOWN AS "THE LOCAL TAX ENABLING ACT."

SECTION 1

That a per capita tax for general revenue purposes be, and the same is hereby levied, on all residents or inhabitants of Shamokin Township, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania, above the age of twenty-one (21) years, in the sum of TEN DOLLARS (\$ 10.00).

SECTION 2

That every resident or inhabitant of Shamokin Township, upon attaining twenty-one (21) years of age, and every person twenty-one (21) years of age or over, becoming a resident or inhabitant of the Township shall notify the duly elected tax assessor of the Township.

SECTION 3

That any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance be, and the same is, hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.

Enacted, Ordained and Passed by the Supervisors of the Township of Shamokin, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania, this 7th day of February, 1968.
