ORDINANCE NO. 2008- 7

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS FOR MOTOR VEHICLES ON ROADWAYS (HOLLY ROAD, HOSTA ROAD AND JASMINE ROAD) WITHIN SHAMOKIN TOWNSHIP, NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS, certain streets or roads exist within Shamokin Township where no speed limits have been established or a change in conditions has occurred to warrant a re-evaluation of the speed limits previously adopted or posted; and

WHEREAS, the Shamokin Township Board of Supervisors, in order to advance the welfare and safety of the residents of the Township and such other persons who use said streets and roads, deems it necessary to enact speed limits on certain streets and roads in Shamokin Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, after completing engineering and traffic studies of the following streets and roads, find the following speed limits to be warranted in accordance with the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Shamokin, as follows:

1. The maximum speed limit for both directions of traffic along the highways or parts thereof described below is hereby established at the rate of speed indicated:

Entire length of Hosta Road (Township <del>770</del> 714)

30 mph

Entire length of Jasmine Road (Township  
Road 762)

25 mph

2. This Ordinance shall be enforced in accordance with the provisions of the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania as it pertains to fines and penalties.


3. Should any provision of this Ordinance be found unconstitutional or otherwise illegal or in any other manner unenforceable, the remaining sections of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
