ORDINANCE NO. 1994 - 1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SHAMOKIN, NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REGULATING MOTOR VEHICLES GENERALLY; ESTABLISHING TRAFFIC REGULATIONS; AUTHORIZING THE REMOVAL AND IMPOUNDMENT OF ILLEGALLY PARKED VEHICLES; AUTHORIZING REGULATIONS DURING SNOW AND ICE EMERGENCIES; AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Shamokin, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania, do hereby establish and ordain, and by this Ordinance hereby adopt and ordain as follows:

Part 1 - General Regulations

Section 101 - Definitions And Interpretation

1. Words and phrases, when used in this ordinance, except for sections or Parts to which different or additional definitions apply, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Vehicle Code (the Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162 No. 81), as amended, except that, in this ordinance, the word "street" may be used interchangeably with the word "highway", and shall have the same meaning as the word "highway" as defined in the Vehicle Code.

2. In this ordinance, the singular shall include the plural, the plural shall include the singular, and the masculine shall

include the feminine.

Section 102 - Manner Of Adopting Permanent Traffic And Parking Regulations

All traffic and parking regulations of a permanent nature shall be enacted as ordinances, as parts of ordinances, as amendments to ordinances, or as amendments to this ordinance, except where the law specifically authorizes less formal action.

Section 103 - Temporary And Emergency Regulations

The Board of Supervisors shall have the following powers to regulate traffic and parking temporarily and in time of emergency:

- (a) in the case of fire, flood, storm or other emergency, to establish temporary traffic and/or parking regulations; and
- (b) in the case of emergency or to facilitate public works, to restrict or prohibit traffic and/or parking in limited areas for periods of not more than seventy-two (72) hours.

Such temporary and emergency regulations may be enforced in the same manner as permanent regulations. Any person who shall operate or park a vehicle or tractor in violation of any such regulations, or who shall move, remove, destroy, injure or deface any sign or marking erected, posted or made to give notice of any such regulation, shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to the penalty set forth in the law or elsewhere in this ordinance for a violation of such nature, and, in case of a violation for which no

specific penalty is set forth in the law or elsewhere in this ordinance, to a fine of not more than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars together with costs of prosecution.

Section 104 - Traffic On Streets Closed Or Restricted For
Construction, Maintenance Or Special Events

1. The Board of Supervisors shall have authority to close any street or specific part of a street to vehicular traffic and to place barriers at each end of the closed portion, while construction or maintenance work is under way or a special event is being conducted on the closed portion. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle upon any such closed portion.

2. The Board of Supervisors shall have authority to establish a restricted traffic area upon any street where construction or maintenance work is under way and to station flagmen at each end of the restricted portion. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle upon any such restricted traffic area at any time when the flagman is displaying a sign directing that vehicle to stop, or is signaling that vehicle, by a flag or other device, not to proceed.

3. Any person who violates any provision of this section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars and costs.

Section 105 - Repealer

All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 106 - Severability

If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors that this section would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section, or part thereof not been included herein.

Section 107 - Effective Date

This ordinance shall become effective on May 1, 1994.

Part 2 - Traffic Regulations

Section 201 - Maximum Speed limits Established On Certain Streets

1. Maximum speed limits are established on portions of specified streets, as follows, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle, on any part of a street where a maximum speed limit applies, at a higher speed than the maximum prescribed for that part of the street:

Old Reading Road (TR-485)	Hosta Drive (TR-716) and Meadowview Circle Drive (TR-486)	35 m.p.h.
Old Reading Road (TR-485)	Meadowview Circle Drive (TR-486) and Pennsylvania Route 61	25 m.p.h.

2. Any person who violates any provision of this section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of Thirty-five (\$35.00) Dollars. Any person exceeding the maximum speed limit by more than five (5) miles per hour shall pay an additional fine of Two (\$2.00) Dollars per mil for each mile in excess of five (5) miles per hour over the maximum speed limit.

Section 202 - Stop Intersections Established

1. The following intersections are established as stop intersections, and official stop signs shall be erected (or are ratified if previously erected) in such a position as to face traffic approaching the second-named street (the intersecting or through street) on the first-named street (the stop street) in the direction or directions indicated for that intersection. Every driver of a vehicle approaching the intersection on the first named or stop street, in the direction indicated in each case, shall stop the vehicle as required by Section 3323(b) of the Vehicle Code, and shall not proceed into or across the second-named or intersecting or through street until he has followed all applicable requirements of that section of the law.

2. Any person who violates any provision of this section

shall, upon convictions, be sentenced to pay a fine of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars and costs.

Part 3 - Snow And Ice Emergency

Section 301 - Declaration Of Snow And Ice Emergency

In order to facilitate the movement of traffic and to combat the hazards of snow and ice on the snow emergency routes named in Section 303 of this Part, the Board of Supervisors, in their discretion, may declare a snow and ice emergency (designated in this Part as a "snow emergency"). Information on the existence of a snow emergency shall be given by the Board of Supervisors through radio, newspaper or other available media, and information on the termination of the emergency may be given by use of the same media.

Section 302 - Parking Prohibited, Driving Motor Vehicles Restricted, On Snow Emergency Routes During Emergency

After any snow emergency is declared, it shall be unlawful, at any time during the continuance of the emergency, for any person:

- (a) to park a motor vehicle or to allow that vehicle to remain parked anywhere on any snow emergency route designated in Section 303 of this Part; or
- (b) to drive any motor vehicle on any such snow emergency route, unless that vehicle is equipped with snow tires or chains.

Section 303 - Snow Emergency Routes Designated

The following are designated as snow emergency routes:

Section 304 - Penalty For Violation

1. If, at any time during a period of snow emergency declared under Section 301 of this Part, a person shall park a motor vehicle or allow a motor vehicle to remain parked anywhere upon a snow emergency route, that person shall be guilty of a violation of this Part, and, upon conviction, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars and costs.

2. If, at any time during a period of snow emergency declared under Section 301 of this Part, a person shall drive a motor vehicle upon a snow emergency route, without having that vehicle equipped with snow tires or chains, that person shall be guilty of a violation of this Part, and, upon conviction, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars and costs.
