ORDINANCE NO. 2000 - 1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SHAMOKIN, NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1994-1, SECTION 201(1) BY ADDING LARCH ROAD THERETO.

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Shamokin, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania, do hereby establish and ordain, and by this Ordinance hereby adopt and ordain as follows:

Section 1.

Section 201(1) of Ordinance 1994-1 is hereby amended as follows:

Part 2 - Traffic Regulations

Section 201 - Maximum Speed limits Established On Certain Streets

1. Maximum speed limits are established on portions of specified streets, as follows, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle, on any part of a street where a maximum speed limit applies, at a higher speed than the maximum prescribed for that part of the street:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Maximum Speed Limit</u>
Old Reading Road (TR-485)	Hosta Drive (TR-716) and Meadowview Circle Drive (TR-486)	35 m.p.h.
Larch Road	Entire length	35 m.p.h.
Old Reading Road (TR-485)	Meadowview Circle Drive (TR-486) and Pennsylvania Route 61	25 m.p.h.

2. Any person who violates any provision of this section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of Thirty-five (\$35.00) Dollars. Any person exceeding the maximum speed limit by more than five (5) miles per hour shall pay an additional fine of Two (\$2.00) Dollars per mile for each mile in excess of five (5) miles per hour over the maximum speed limit.

Section 2.

The remainder of Ordinance 1994-1 is hereby ratified and re-adopted in its entirety as though set forth herein.
