The following is a report of the Stonington Volunteer Fire Company for December 2011.

The fire company responded to 4 emergency calls.

There were 2 calls in Shamokin Township, 1 call in Snyderstown Borough and 1 call in Rockefeller Township.

1 MVA, 1 Fluids Down from an MVA, 1 Medical Assist and 1 Emergency Standby in quarters.

BREAK DOWN BY LOCATION OF CALL

12-02-11, Rockefeller Twp., Route 890, MVA.

12-03-11, Shamokin Twp., Route 61, Fluids Down from an MVA.

12-18-11, Shamokin Twp., Emergency Standby in Quarters, Station 6-3.

12-25-11, Snyderstown Borough, Snyderstown Road, Medical Assist for Lifting.

On behalf of the Fire Company, I want to thank the Township Supervisors for their financial assistance of \$10,000. towards our brush truck. This was applied directly towards the principle owed. Your support and assistance is a big help. I want to personally thank the Supervisors, working with them on this project over the past year and to bring it to a conclusion that everyone feels good about shows that we can work together to provide the latest and safest apparatus and equipment to protect the residents and those passing through Shamokin Township during fires and other emergencies that may occur.

For 2012, I am requesting the Supervisors again allow the Fire Company \$2,000. In Fuel allowance. Also, due to the September flooding and heavy rains after the flood, our fuel usage went over the \$2,000. allowed for 2011 by \$350.14. I am asking the Township Supervisors if they would absorb this overage.

In regards to the Insurance issue, I am pleased to inform you that the Fire Company, at our last meeting, approved the insurance coverage offered by the Township Supervisors at the last Township Meeting. Again, this has been something between the Fire Company and the Supervisors for some time. A few months ago, I have assigned any insurance matters to our Directors. Mark Kramer is the point person. I will direct all inquiries relating to insurance to him.

These are all savings for the Fire Company that will be a great help financially to us, and I want to thank the Supervisors for their support on these matters. This shows that through hard work and negotiations we can reach an agreement that helps one another and all parties can support.
