They have been to the station to conduct the survey and the Fire Company will sign the agreement with them. Everything will be sent to them and I will give a copy of everything to the Supervisors once complete.

Just an FYI, the Fire Company is looking to purchase a 1999 American LaFrance fire engine to replace the 1989 E-One currently in service.

I am requesting the Township agree again this year to provide \$2,000. In fuel for the Fire Company.
