The regular monthly meeting of the Shamokin Township Supervisors was held on March 10, 2021 at 7:30 p.m. at the Shamokin Township Municipal Building.

In attendance were Supervisors Gregory Rachau, John Klinger, and Paul Rapp, Solicitor Jim Bathgate, Roadmaster Jon Clemens, Sewage Officer Ken Young and 5 visitors.

Supervisor Rachau moved, seconded by Supervisor Rapp to approve the February minutes as presented. Motion was passed unanimously.

The Treasurer's Report was read and approved on a motion by Supervisor Rachau seconded by Supervisor Klinger. Motion was passed unanimously.

Solicitor's Report

Supervisor Klinger moved, seconded by Supervisor Rapp to adopt Ordinance 2021-3 an ordinance providing of cable television service be authorized by franchise with Service Electric Cablevision. Motion was passed unanimously.

Solicitor Bathgate presented a tax collection agreement with Keystone Collection for the collection of business privilege and local services taxes for three years beginning in 2022. After three years the contract would automatically renew unless directed otherwise. Supervisor Klinger moved, Supervisor Rapp to approve the tax collection agreement with Keystone Collections for business privilege and local services taxes. Motion was passed unanimously.

Road Dept.

Roadmaster Jon Clemens reported on the Poppy Road bridge. The engineer hired by Penn DOT to inspect the bridge is requesting that the bridge be repaired as soon as possible. Seda-COG, who responsible for the bridge repair, has applied for a grant and will not know anything until April.

Roadmaster Clemens reported he requested a study from Penn DOT for the stop sign on Holly Road.

Mr. Clemens reported that the insulation on the building was all wet and will need to be replaced. A quote will be sought.

Mr. Clemens reported that stone bids are due at the next COG meeting and road project requests will be due at the next meeting.

Nuisance Complaints

Supervisor Rachau read a letter from KPI concerning the nuisance complaints. They are working on a property on Holly Road.

DEP Grant-Bank Stabilization

Solicitor Bathgate reported that there was no report on the bank stabilization grant from DEP.

Ralpho Township

A letter was received concerning the intent of Ralpho Township Municipal Authority for the renewal of the NPDES permit.

Workers Comp

Solicitor Bathgate will reach out to Rockefeller Township and Snyderstown Borough requesting assistance with the Worker's Comp invoice for the Stonington Fire Company.

Insurance

Tony Rosini of Myers & Lynch reported on the insurance dividend and a savings on the fire company insurance of \$200.00.

Second Amendment Sanctuary

Supervisor Klinger made a motion to draft a resolution to make Shamokin township a second amendment sanctuary, Supervisor Rachau made the second. Motion was passed unanimously.

Supervisor Rachau moved, seconded by Supervisor Klinger to adjourn the meeting at 7:50 p.m. and to pay the invoices. Motion was passed unanimously.
