The regular monthly meeting of the Shamokin Township Supervisors was held on May 12, 2021 at 7:30 p.m. at the Shamokin Township Municipal Building.

In attendance were Supervisors Gregory Rachau, John Klinger, and Paul Rapp, Solicitor Jim Bathgate, Roadmaster Jon Clemens, Sewage Officer Ken Young, Secretary/Treasurer Stephanie McKinney and no visitors.

Supervisor Rapp moved, seconded by Supervisor Rachau to approve the April minutes as presented. Motion was passed unanimously.

The Treasurer's Report was read and approved on a motion by Supervisor Klinger seconded by Supervisor Rapp. Motion was passed unanimously.

#### Road Dept.

Roadmaster Jon Clemens stated there was no report on the Poppy Road bridge.

Concerning the County Action Plan, Mr. Clemens reported that they are working on setting up sub committees. Mr. Clemens will be appointed to the Ag subcommittee and the governmental subcommittee.

#### COG

Mr. Clemens reported the low bidder for seal coating was Russel Standard Corp at \$142,278.58. Supervisor Rachau moved, seconded by Supervisor Klinger to approve the seal coat bid with the low bidder Russel Standard at \$142,278.58. Motion was passed unanimously.

#### Nuisance Complaints

Concerning a nuisance complaint on Holly Road, Solicitor Bathgate reported that he viewed the property and determined that there is a sufficient problem to bring it before the magistrate. Supervisor Rachau moved, seconded by Supervisor Klinger to continue to move forward with the Holly Road property and bring it before the District Magistrate. Motion was passed unanimously.

Supervisor Rapp asked about similar properties in the township that also need cleaned up. Solicitor Bathgate noted that the ordinance is adopted with the policy that a written complaint must be received in order for an investigation to begin.

### Fire Co. Workers Comp

Secretary McKinney reported that the township received \$1,100 from Snyderstown Borough and \$1,950 from Rockefeller Township to help with the Workers Comp premium for the Fire Company.

### American Rescue Plan Funding

Secretary McKinney and Roadmaster Clemens plan to attend a PSATS webinar concerning the spending of the American Rescue Plan Funding.

### Creek Dumping

A complaint was received from the owner of a one site camp site along the creek on Snyderstown Road. The owner had a problem that when the water rises and recedes there is a lot of garbage such as glass and furniture.

The board responded that not much can be done unless a person is caught dumping.

### Penn DOT-Traffic Signals

A letter was received from Penn DOT concerning their spring and summer road projects. Seal coating is to be done on Badman's Hill Road, Irish Valley Road and Hollow Road.

### ATV Accident

Solicitor Bathgate informed the board that a notice came from a lawyer concerning an ATV accident in April near the traffic light at Routes 61 & 487. The notice stated that any and all communications, inspections, and videos in regard the traffic light should be preserved for review.

### Tire Clean Up

A tire clean up will be held October 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Supervisor Rachau moved, seconded by Supervisor Rapp to adjourn the meeting at 7:46 p.m. and to pay the invoices. Motion was passed unanimously.
