

**TOWNSHIP OF SHAMOKIN
NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
ORDINANCE NO. 2022 - 2**

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND RATIFYING ALL PROVISIONS OF THE NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY STORMWATER MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE AS THE ENACTMENT GOVERNING STORMWATER MANAGEMENT WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF SHAMOKIN, NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the mandate of the Pennsylvania Stormwater Management Act, 32 P.S. §680.1 *et seq.*, (the "Act"), the Northumberland County Commissioners have adopted a county-wide Stormwater Management Plan (the "Plan");

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11(b) of the Act, each municipality within Northumberland County must enact or amend, and implement, such ordinances as are necessary to regulate development in a manner consistent with the Plan;

WHEREAS, on May 3, 2022, the Northumberland County Commissioners adopted the Northumberland County Stormwater Management Ordinance (the "County Ordinance"), which is effective on a county-wide basis unless superseded by local ordinance;

WHEREAS, the governing body of Shamokin Township has determined that the provisions of the County Ordinance are appropriate to the needs of the Township, and the adoption of a superseding local ordinance is unnecessary at this time;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Shamokin Township concurs the Stormwater Management Site Plan and Report requirements of Article IV of the County Ordinance.


AND NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township of Shamokin, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

1. The Shamokin Township Board of Supervisors hereby adopts and ratifies all provisions of the Northumberland County Stormwater Management Ordinance as the enactment governing Stormwater Management within Shamokin Township.


2. This Ordinance is intended to comply with Section 11(b) of the Pennsylvania Stormwater Management Act.
