AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SHAMOKIN,  
NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING  
ORDINANCE NO. 2009-1, NUISANCE ORDINANCE, TO AMEND THE  
DEFINITIONS OF JUNK AND TRASH/GARBAGE/RUBBISH TO  
INCLUDE ANYTHING THAT CAN BE SEEN FROM ANY PUBLIC  
STREET, HIGHWAY, ROAD OF THE TOWNSHIP OR STATE, PRIVATE  
ROAD, DRIVEWAY, OR ADJOINING PROPERTY LINE.

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Shamokin, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania, do hereby establish and ordain, by this Ordinance hereby adopt and ordain as follows:

Ordinance No. 2009-1, Nuisance Ordinance shall be amended as follows:

**SECTION 2**  
**Definitions**

Junk – including but not limited to, unused or abandoned machinery, equipment or appliances, all forms of waste and refuse type materials, including scrap metal, tires, glass, industrial waste or the like, that can be seen from any public street, highway, road of the township or state, private road, driveway, or adjoining property line.


Trash/Garbage/Rubbish - including but not limited to, trash, paper, cartons, boxes, barrels (not actively used for lawful burning), wood, furniture, bedding, metals, cans, etc., that can be seen from any public street, highway, road of the township or state, private road, driveway, or adjoining property line.

The remainder of Ordinance No. 2009-1 is hereby ratified and readopted in its entirety as though set forth herein.
