The regular monthly meeting of the Shamokin Township Supervisors was held on April 10, 2024 at 7:30 p.m. at the Shamokin Township Municipal Building.

In attendance were Vice Chairman John Klinger, Supervisor Paul Rapp, Solicitor Jim Bathgate, Roadmaster Jon Clemens, Secretary/Treasurer Stephanie McKinney and 7 visitors.

Supervisor Rapp moved, seconded by Supervisor Klinger to approve the March minutes as presented. Motion was passed unanimously.

The Treasurer's Report was read and approved on a motion by Supervisor Rapp seconded by Supervisor Klinger. Motion was passed unanimously.

#### Solicitor's Report

No report.

#### Building Addition

Ceiling tile was received, the doors would be here this week, the HVAC is complete, and furniture needs to be discussed. Supervisor Rapp presented a quote from A+ Office Supplies for desks and chairs.

#### Poppy Road Bridge

The yearly inspection of the Poppy Road bridge was completed and there are no changes.

#### Apple Blossom Lane

Concerning drainage issues on Apple Blossom Lane, KPI will be reaching out to the property owners.

#### Roadmaster Report

Mr. Clemens reported that the cinders are full and the snow plows are off the trucks.

Mr. Clemens reported that the Count Conservation District moved to Housels Run Road. The driveway for the office needs work but it does not qualify for a Dirt and Gravel grant because it is private. Mr. Clemens asked, since they have done so much for the township, if the Conservation District bought the stone could they help them place the stone. Supervisor Rapp moved, seconded by Supervisor Klinger to allow the road crew to help the Conservation District with their driveway. Motion was passed unanimously.

## Council of Government

The stone bids were received by the COG from Meckley's Limestone and New Enterprise. The low bidder for Anti-Skid, #57, 2A sub-base, and 2RC was Meckley's Limestone with a township contract cost of \$67,450.00. The low bid for Rip Rap was New Enterprise with a total contract cost of \$15,845.00. Supervisor Rapp moved, seconded by Supervisor Klinger to approve the low bidders for stone Meckley's Limestone Products and New Enterprise Stone. Motion was passed unanimously.

## Nuisance Complaints

A nuisance complaint was received about a nuisance property on Costa Road. The board forwarded the complaint to KPI.

Supervisor Klinger moved, seconded by Supervisor Rapp to adjourn the meeting at 7:42 p.m. and to pay the bills. Motion was passed unanimously.
